- 2. That para. 3 is stricken from the Water Master Amended Agreement in its entirety,
- 3. That "shall" is changed to "may" in the Orland Unit Water Users' Association co-location clause in para. 5 of the Water Master Agreement,
- 4. That the Clerk's office consult with the Administrative Office of the Courts as to the nature of the Water Master's records and if it be determined that those records are records of the Court, that they henceforth are cared for in a manner appropriate for such Court records.
- 5. That the Clerk's office consult with the Administrative Office of the Courts and determine the appropriate employment or contractor status and compensation level for the Water Master and that such status and compensation level be ordered, but if it be determined that the Water Master is an independent contractor not subject to the rules or procedures of the Clerk or the Administrative Office the compensation of the Water Master shall thereafter be set to a new annual level of \_\_\_\_\_\_ from its current level of \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 6. That the Clerk's office consult with the Administrative Office of the Courts on the proper manner of acquiring larger office space, furnishings, computer equipment and an assistant for the Water Master as detailed in defendant Barkley's Memorandum in Support of Motion and that upon determining the proper manner, either the Clerk or the Water Master as appropriate is oredered to carry out that determination.
- 7. That the Water Master is ordered to accept the interpretations described in defendant Barkley's Memorandum in Support of his Motion in Paragraphs IV, V, and VI or else defend his positions to the contrary with specific quotes of the page, paragraph, and exact text from the Decree.
- 8. That for instances where the Water Master agrees with the assertions of defendant therein that the described diversions violate the Decree, the Water Master take prompt action to halt those diversions, or present a proper complaint to the Court or to the California State Water Resources Board to halt them.
- 9. That the Water Master is ordered to begin the analyses and tabulations in paragraph V as described in defendant Barkley's Memorandum in Support of his Motion and present to this
