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Last week, Mr. Barkley filed a Petition for Writ of Mandate in the Superior Court for the State of California, County of Sacramento, No. 34-2010-80000513 (filed April 12, 2010). A true and correct copy of that Petition, delivered to the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) on April 15, 2010, is attached as Exhibit A. The state court Petition relates to Mr. Barkley's pending motion for reconsideration before the SWRCB regarding Reclamation's application for an extension of Permit 18115 to operate Black Butte Dam and Reservoir. Mr. Barkley's Petition asks the state court to "find that the Angle Decree preempts State jurisdiction to allocate surface flows to anyone bound by the Decree, which includes USA, and therefore SWRCB has no jurisdiction to even consider" the Reclamation application. Exhibit A at 8.

Mr. Barkley filed a "Notice of Related Case" with the state court, listing *United States of America v. H.C. Angle* as related. Exhibit A at 4. Although it may qualify as "related" under state court rules, the Petition does not appear to qualify as a "related case" under a strict reading of Local Rule 83-123 of this court. Because the state court Petition does relate directly to matters pending before this court, however, the United States files this notice to alert this court regarding the pendency of Mr. Barkley's newly filed state court Petition.
